Public Transport

The [Brussels Transport Authority](#) (STIB/MIVB) is the main public transport operator in Brussels. Its trams, buses and underground trains form a single network and you can easily transfer from one mode to another using the same ticket.

Bus

Buses 27 and 38 run from the city centre to Place Luxembourg
Buses 12 and 21 run from Brussels International Airport to Place Luxembourg

Underground

Lines 1 and 5 to Maelbeek and Schuman (10-minute walk to Parliament)

Lines 2 and 6 to Trône (7 minute-walk to Parliament).
